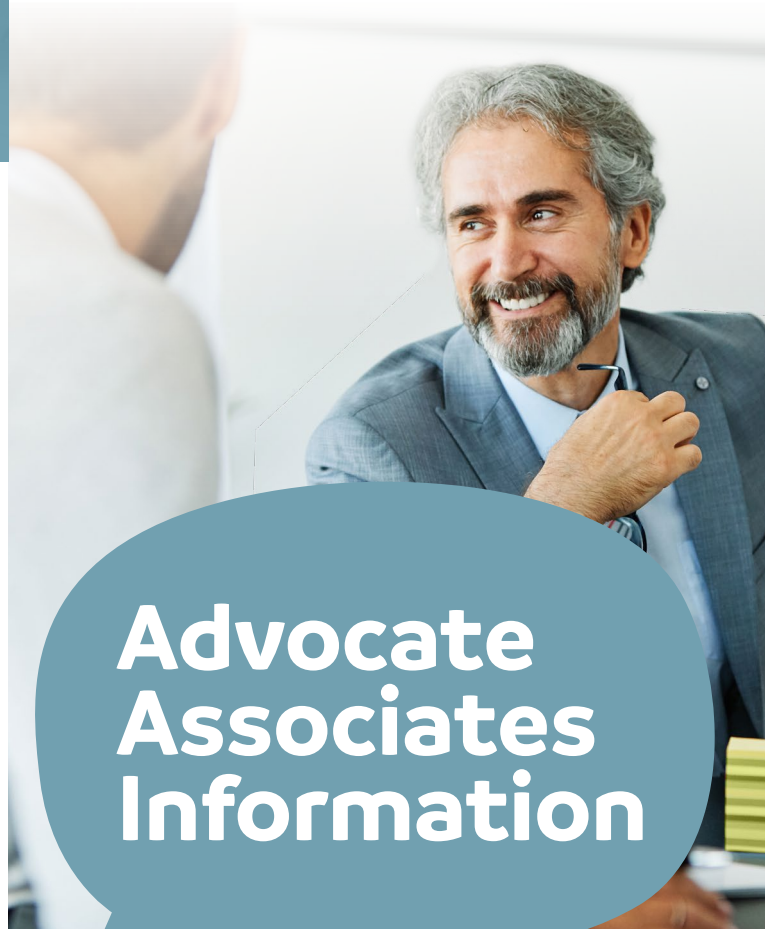

Advocate Associates believe in the concept of Citizen Advocacy.

- Citizen Advocates themselves.
- Asked to act directly on specific issues but rather to provide support ONLY.

Advocate Associates Can:

- Help the Advocate understand how the system works.
- Offer emotional support to Advocates involved in difficult actions on behalf of their Protégé.
